## Visit Weardale. A great place to be outdoor and active with marvelous wildlife and plenty to see and do.

High moorland expanses, tranquil dales, tumbling rivers and waterfalls, exciting wildlife, dramatic history, vibrant communities, outstanding scenery – this is the North Pennines. Weardale, one of the Durham Dales, is part of this spectacular area of countryside - a fine example of what makes the area such a priceless national asset.

The North Pennines was designated as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) in 1988. AONBs are nationally Protected Landscapes which are given the same protection as, and are recognized as the equal of, our National Parks.

A great place to find out about the area is the **Durham Dales Centre** in Stanhope – with its tearooms, gift and craft shops it's perfect for a leisurely afternoon.

Weardale is a special part of the North Pennines, a place where you can stretch your legs, spread your wings and explore one of our finest landscapes. This is perfect country for walking, cycling, horse riding, fishing, and wildlife watching. Whether you're looking for riverside wanders or more challenging routes you'll be spoilt for choice! You'll find traffic-free family cycling, mountain biking and woodland walks in the nearby **Hamsterley Forest**.

You can even enjoy a dip in the heated Weardale **Open Air Swimming Pool** in Stanhope, play a round at **Crook Golf Club** or strap on your skis and indulge in some winter sports at the **Weardale Ski Club** – snow permitting! Take a ride on the **Weardale Railway** – a heritage line running between Stanhope and Bishop Auckland – a great way to immerse yourself in the natural beauty of the landscape.

Weardale has a distinctive character, with attractive settlements to explore, such as Stanhope, Rookhope, Wolsingham and St. John's Chapel. The area's rich industrial heritage can be seen in the remains of our lead mining past, and you can see how the miners lived and worked on a visit to family-friendly **Killhope, the North of England Lead Mining Museum**.

Don't forget to stop off at the fascinating **Weardale Museum in Ireshopeburn**, where you can see the Weardale Tapestry and marvel at the historic **High House Chapel**.

A great way to get to grips with the rural way of life is to join the locals at one of the many **agricultural shows** in August and September, or pop along to **Stanhope Farmers' Market** and stock up on local goodies.

Wildlife thrives in Weardale and the wider North Pennines - red squirrels (which can be seen on the squirrel trail at **Killhope Museum**), otters, black grouse and thousands of breeding wading birds can all be found here. In late spring and early summer our glorious traditional hay meadows are awash with colourful wildflowers whilst in August the moors burst into purple splendour as the heather blooms.









The rocks and landscapes of Weardale and the North Pennines have amazing stories to tell, of moving continents and tropical seas, of molten rock and ice sheets, of minerals and the men that mined them. As well as being an AONB the North Pennines is a European and Global Geopark – a UNESCO-endorsed accolade which reflects the area's world-class geological heritage.





One day won't be enough, so why not stay for several? You'll find a wide variety of accommodation to suit all tastes from luxury hotel to cosy bed and breakfast, from self-catering cottage or caravan to bunkhouse and campsite.
